










Q5. Does the Board of Nursing administer or outsource assistive personnel initial competency examinations? (Check all that apply)




Q6. Which type of exam is required by the Board of Nursing for assistive personnel initial competency examinations?


Q7. Does the Board of Nursing maintain a registry of assistive personnel employed in nursing homes?


Q8. Does the Board of Nursing maintain a registry of assistive personnel employed in home health care agencies?

Q9. Does the Board of Nursing have the authority to take disciplinary action on assistive personnel licenses?


