Well, it's true that some intentional or malicious misuses of social media do occur, the majority of inappropriate disclosures or postings are unintentional. Usually they're the result of the mistaken belief that the communication or posting is private and accessible only by the int

Remember, increased access to communication through social media does not change the healthcare professional's responsibility to protect patient information. In fact it actually makes it easier to inappropriately share information. By carefully following standardized guidelines, healthcare professionals can responsibly use social media to improve the coordination of patient care.
